

Food Defense and Visitor/Contractor Program

PURPOSE

1.1. The purpose of this document is to define the Food Defense and Visitor/Contractor plan for Midwest Assembly, Warehouse & Distribution.

2. RESPONSIBILITIES

- **2.1.** The Warehouse Manager and Equipment Health and Safety Coordinator are responsible for overseeing and implementing the food defense program.
- 2.2. All employees are responsible for ensuring visitors/contractors comply with the MAWD visitor policy.

3. PROCEDURE

- 3.1. The FSIS Industry Self-Assessment Checklist for Food Security has been completed.
 - **3.1.1.** The checklist is reviewed on an annual basis.
- **3.2.** Doors/Entryways
 - **3.2.1.** All exterior doors are locked to prevent unauthorized entry.
- 3.3. Visitors/Contractors
 - **3.3.1.** All visitors/contractors must check-in at the main office.
 - **3.3.2.** Each visitor/contractor is required to read the Visitor Agreement and sign-in on the visitor log before entering the facility.
 - **3.3.3.** Visitors/contractors are provided with an orange reflective vest and must wear it when entering the warehouse for identification purposes.
 - **3.3.4.** Visitors/contractors are expected to comply with all MAWD/Good Manufacturing Practice policies and procedures while on the premises.
 - **3.3.5.** Visitors may be required to be escorted unless they have received Good Manufacturing Practice training.
 - **3.3.6.** Visitors/contractors are not permitted to use company equipment or resources without permission.



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- **3.3.7.** Each visitor/contractor shall be aware of forklift traffic and use good judgement when walking through the warehouse.
- **3.3.8.** Any unauthorized visitors found on the premises will be asked to leave immediately.

3.4. Drivers

- 3.4.1. Drivers must check in at the front office to receive their dock assignment.
- 3.4.2. Drivers must be granted access to the facility by an employee.
- 3.4.3. Drivers' access to the facility is restricted to the dock area only.
- 3.4.4. If a driver needs to return to the main office or use the restroom after docking, they will be required to wear an orange reflective vest when walking through the warehouse.
- 3.4.5. Drivers should be aware of forklift traffic and use good judgement when walking through the warehouse.
